At Lavit Gallery, \fXILE unfolds across two vaults. In one, a long-form film commissioned by Sirius Arts Centre, an essay in image and sound built from the excavation of place as memory. In the second vault, a suspended ladder is activated by a feedback system, sending tremors through its body that sound the vault. Architecture here is a resonant structure, held under tension. Visitors move between film and mechanism, image and matter. \fXILE is a condition of encounter: a crossing held in suspension, a body leaning within compressed space.

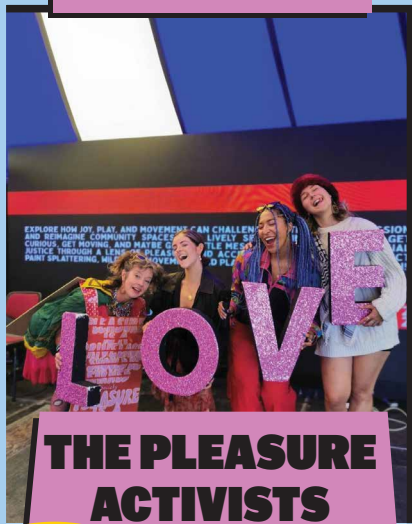

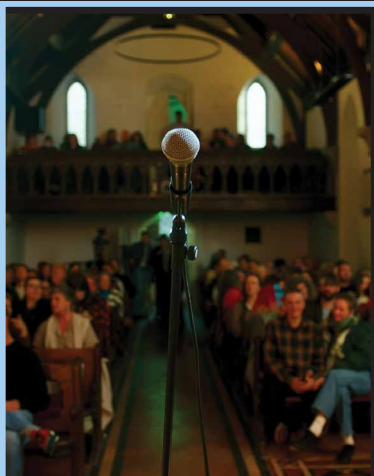

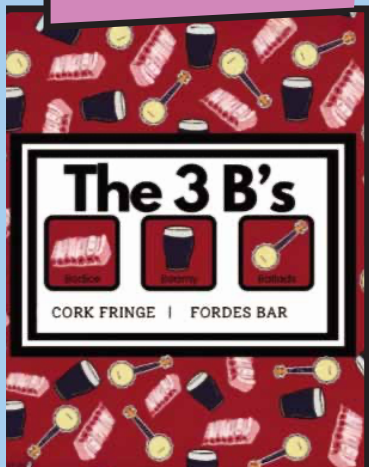

BLANK, BLANK, BLANK is an intimate experimental audio visual performance that reimagines how audiences experience electronic music. The artist performs hidden behind a suspended sheet while their shadow and sound reactive visuals are projected to the audience. Instead of focusing on the performer, attention shifts toward sound, movement and atmosphere. Live visuals respond directly to the music being created, forming a dialogue between sound and projection. By removing the performer's visible identity, the work encourages deeper listening, reduced phone use and a heightened sense of immersion. The result is a shared sensory environment where audiences feel inside the performance rather than simply watching it.
